

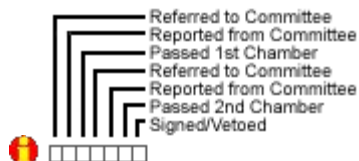

HB 172

Burns, Tim



Provides for the inclusion of information in certain petitions as relates to civil petitions regarding latent diseases.

Specific Remarks:

OPPOSE The LSBA opposes this bill as it is generally opposed to the creation of special procedures and/or circumstances within the Code of Civil Procedure

HB 223

Smiley



Creates and provides for a Tax Court as an administrative agency in the office of the governor.

Specific Remarks:

OPPOSE The LSBA is opposed to this bill as it proposes to take jurisdiction away from the judicial branch and give it to the executive branch

HB 255

Burrell



Authorizes domestic abuse advocates to assist petitioners in making an application for a protective order.

Specific Remarks:

OPPOSE While the LSBA is in favor of providing assistance to victims of domestic abuse, it is opposed to this bill as the LSBA believes that the bill creates an unauthorized practice of law

Signed by Governor; Act 234

HB 257

Johnson

Provides for ex officio financial institution notaries.



Specific Remarks: **OPPOSE** The LSBA is opposed to the bill because it would allow otherwise untrained individuals to serve as in-house notaries for banks

HB 274

Lambert

Provides relative to hospital security and police jurisdiction.



Specific Remarks: **OPPOSE** The LSBA opposes this bill because of the House of Delegates policy in opposition to immunities

HB 280

Richardson

Provides disclosure procedures for asbestos and silica claims.

Specific Remarks: **OPPOSE** The LSBA opposes this bill as the LSBA is generally opposed to the creation of special procedures and/or circumstances within the Code of Civil Procedure

HB 358

Greene

Provides a limitation of liability for school boards entering into joint-use agreements.



Specific Remarks: **OPPOSE** The LSBA opposes this bill because of the House of Delegates policy in opposition to immunities

Signed by Governor; Act 351

HB 445

Chaney

Provides relative to the notices of repossession.



Specific Remarks: **OPPOSE** The LSBA opposes this bill as an access to justice issue because the bill eliminates the requirement that a repossession agent obtain a copy of the notice indicating the right to take possession of collateral

Signed by Governor; Act 358

HB 563

Cortez

Provides for surface and subsurface restoration.



Specific Remarks: **OPPOSE** The LSBA opposes this bill because of the House of Delegates policy in opposition to immunities

HB 564

Seabaugh

Provides relative to surface and subsurface restoration under a mineral lease or servitude.



Specific Remarks: **OPPOSE** The LSBA opposes this bill because of the House of Delegates policy in opposition to immunities

HB 578

Bishop

Provides for immunity from liability for homeowners associations.

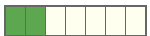


Specific Remarks: **OPPOSE** The LSBA opposes this bill because of the House of Delegates policy in opposition to immunities

Morrell

Changes the definition of convicted. Became SB 272.

Specific Remarks: **OPPOSE** The LSBA opposes this bill because the bill proposes to broaden the definition of convicted to include juveniles in cases of both felony-grade and misdemeanor-grade acts

SB 146

Adley

Provides relative to oilfield sites or exploration and production sites.

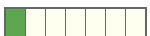


Specific Remarks: **OPPOSE** The LSBA opposes this bill because of the House of Delegates policy in opposition to immunities

SB 149

Morrish

Provides with respect to the health care provider privileges.



Specific Remarks:

OPPOSE The LSBA opposes this bill because it negates contractual obligations that health care providers have already entered into with insurance carriers

SB 209

Cheek



Allow private companies to monitor the criminal justice information system by providing real time electronic access to the system.

Specific Remarks:

OPPOSE The LSBA opposes as private companies should not be involved

SB 240

Chabert



Provides relative to oysters leases.

Specific Remarks:

OPPOSE The LSBA opposes this bill because of the House of Delegates policy in opposition to immunities
