

**HB 116** 

Stiaes

Prohibits the destruction of biological evidence collected pursuant to the investigation of certain criminal offenses.

Specific Remarks: The LSBA SUPPORTS this bill subject to the removal of the end date or a viable explanation as to why there is an end date

**HB 119** 

Seabaugh

Provides relative to search warrants for bodily samples.

Specific Remarks:

Consistent with the House of Delegates policy in opposition to immunities, the LSBA OPPOSES this bill unless the civil and criminal immunities are removed. If removed, the LSBA would support

HB 230

Moreno

Amends provisions relative to dismissal of delinquency proceedings.

Specific Remarks:

The LSBA OPPOSES this bill as written but would support an amendment to current law to provide for the requirement of a contradictory hearing prior to dismissal
