From March 2022 to March 2023 Louisiana GAINED a net of 40,200 jobs.






Louisiana added +2.1% more jobs over the last year, ranking 32nd nationwide

GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT


Louisiana's GDP fell by 1.8% on an annual basis in the fourth quarter of 2022. This ranked 49th—second to last.
