#### LOUISIANA NEEDS A COMEBACK

Louisiana's lack of competitiveness is resulting in people fleeing the state, making many labor market measures look better than the struggles faced by many Louisianans. The following are highlights of key data and comparisons with neighboring states that show the need for a comeback in the Pelican State.

#### JOBS

From September 2022 to September 2023 Louisiana GAINED a net of 46,000 jobs.






Louisiana added +2.4% more jobs over the last year, ranking 12th nationwide

## **GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT**


Louisiana's GDP rose by 1.4% on an annual basis in the first quarter of 2023. This ranked 31st—compared with 2% for all of the US.
